

Dated Dispur, the 27th February, 2017.

Consequent upon the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court passed in WP(C) No.3502/2014 and in consideration of various petitions from the State Govt. pensioners retired from service on or after 01/01/2006 and already availed their first instance of commutation of pension at pre-revised rates, the Governor of Assam is pleased to allow residual commutation of pension arising out of the revision of pay as per ROP 2010, to the category of pensioners indicated below, subject to the following conditions -

- (i) All cases of revised commutation of pension shall be subject to examination by the State Standing Medical Board. Sanction shall be accorded only on receipt of satisfactory Medical Reports.
- (ii) The residual amount of commuted pension i.e. the difference between the pre-revised commuted amount and the revised commuted amount shall be worked out on the basis of the actual age calculated on the next date of birth of the pensioner from the date of his medical examination.
- (iii) The payment of the revised commuted portion of pension will cease to be drawn w.e.f. the date of medical examination of the pensioner. However, the period of restoration (14 Years) will be counted from the date of 1st sanction of commutation or the date of 1st medical examination of the pensioner whichever the case may be.
- (iv) This will be applicable to all those pensioners of post 01/01/2006 who have availed commutation of pension at their pre-revised rate. The pensioners who have already availed their commutation at the revised rate will not come under the purview of this OM.

This will come into force with immediate effect.
