
With reference to your letter cited above, I am directed to say that P & PG Department has decided to allow pension & pensionary benefits to the MR workers (regularised) engaged prior to 01/04/1993 and retired after rendering at least 20 years of continuous service without deduction of initial 6 years of service in order to comply with the order of Hon'ble High Court passed in various cases pertaining to the pension matter of above categories of regularised MR workers.

In order to be given effect to the same, this Department is required to amend / modify its earlier guidelines issued regarding pension / DCRG matter of regularised MR workers. Since, this procedure of amendment / modification necessitates prior views from referral Departments and finally, approval of the Cabinet, a considerable time is required till completion of the entire procedure.

In view of the above and in order to comply with the orders of the Hon'ble High Court, this Department as an interim measure concurs approval towards pension & other retirement benefits (as admissible) to the petitioners who were engaged prior to 01/04/1993 and retired as regularised MR worker with at least 20 years of continuous service without any deductions. The pension and pensionary benefits in such cases shall be paid w.e.f. the date following the date of retirement or from the cut off date i.e. 20/05/2009 as laid down in the OM No. PPG(P) 88/2009/69, dated 04/10/2010, whichever is later.

After Completion of due procedure, the formal order of amendment / modification of relevant OM will be issued covering all other eligible cases.


